


Your Representatives





The Scottish Parliament

The Scottish Parliament makes laws on a range of issues affecting Scotland.

You have eight Members of the Scottish Parliament (MSPs): one for your local area (the constituency) and seven for the wider parliamentary region. You can approach any of the eight.

















Find out who your MSPs are by using the postcode search on the Scottish Parliament's website or by contacting Public Information.

Your MSPs can help you if you have concerns about a matter such as:



Education



Law and order



Health and social services



Housing policy



Transport



Some aspects of welfare



Council

Councils (also known as local authorities) deliver a wide range of public services in your local area.

You have three or four councillors for your local area. You can approach any of them.











Find out who your councillors are on your local council website or by contacting your council.

Council contact details are available from the Convention of Scottish Local Authorities (COSLA).

Your councillors can help you if you have concerns about the delivery of a local public service such as:



Education services



Planning decisions and licensing



Electoral registration



Social care



Parks and leisure services



Waste and recycling





UK Parliament

European Parliament



The UK Parliament makes laws for the whole UK.



You have one Member of Parliament (MP) in the House of Commons in London.

The European Parliament has a role in making laws for the whole European Union, including the UK.







You have six Members of the European Parliament (MEPs). You can approach any of the six.







Find out who your MP is by using the postcode search on the front of the UK Parliament website or by contacting the House of Commons Enquiry Service.

Your MP can help you if you have concerns about a matter such as:



Constitution



Defence



Employment



Foreign policy



Immigration



Welfare


